

Directions to Renziehausen Park Rose Garden and Arboretum

Renziehausen Park Rose Garden and Arboretum is a city park with rose garden and arboretum located on Eden Park Boulevard off Walnut Street, in the Pittsburgh suburb of McKeesport, Pennsylvania. It is open to the public daily without charge

Take Parkway East to Route 30 (Forest Hills) exit and follow Route 30 to Route 148. Turn right on Route 148 and proceed to third traffic signal. (You will see a sign for Penn State Campus at this intersection.) Turn left here onto Eden Park Blvd. and go to the second traffic signal. Turn left on Tulip Dr. and drive straight into the park up to the clubhouse at the end of the road. The rose garden will be on your right as you approach the clubhouse. Take Route 51 south to Lebanon Church Rd. (McKeesport exit). Follow Lebanon Church Rd. past the County Airport. At the fork in the road, take the right fork to Dravosburg—do not take the left fork to Buttermilk Hollow Rd. After right fork, follow the Pittsburgh-McKeesport Blvd. across the Dravosburg Bridge. Turn left after the bridge and follow to Lysle Blvd. through McKeesport. Turn right on Eden Park Blvd. and go to the second traffic signal. Turn left on Tulip Dr. and drive straight into the park up to the clubhouse at the end of the road. The rose garden will be on your right as you approach the clubhouse.

From Monroeville or Pa. Turnpike Exit (57) follow Monroeville Business Route 22W to Route 48S. Turn left onto Route 48 (toward McKeesport) and follow until you reach a “T” intersection. Route 148 will be to the right. Turn right onto Route 148 and go to the first traffic light which is Eden Park Blvd. Turn right on Eden Park and go to the first traffic light which is Tulip Dr. Turn right on Tulip and drive straight into the park up to the clubhouse at the end of the road. The rose garden will be on your right as you approach the clubhouse.

Take your usual route to Kennywood Park. Continue on Rt. 837 past the park. You will see signs indicating you are on the Green Belt. You will go through several lights, and then pass a large sign for the City of Duquesne. Continue traveling on Rt. 837 and you will soon see the Duquesne-McKeesport Bridge. Get into the left lane so that you may cross the bridge. When you come to the end of the bridge, DO NOT take the ramp for McKeesport, instead, go straight ahead following Rt. 148N. Stay in the right lane and go to the third traffic light which will be Eden Park Blvd. Turn right on Eden Park and go to the second traffic light. Turn left on tulip Dr. and drive straight into the park up to the clubhouse at the end of the road. The rose garden will be on your right as you approach the clubhouse.
