GENERAL RULES FOR HORTICULTURE:

1. This show is governed by the rules and regulations of the American Rose Society for the exhibition of garden roses as they appear in the Guidelines and Rules for Judging Roses as amended. Entries in violation of ARS or show rules will be disqualified. In case of any conflict between the schedule and the guidelines, this schedule will govern.
2. The horticulture preparation area will be open at 8 am on Saturday, September 14, 2019. Horticulture entries may be placed between 8:30 am and 11:00 am at the Bidwell Training Center.
3. Judging will begin at 11:15 am. ONLY members of the Show Committee, judges, and clerks assigned to the show are allowed in the show area during judging. The decision of the judges is FINAL.
4. Entries must be entered using the approved ARS exhibition name as listed in the following: *Official List of Approved Exhibition Names, Handbook for Selecting Roses*, and the online *Modern Roses* database. If the variety is not listed in any of the above official ARS sources, then the *Combined Rose List (CRL)* may be used as a reference.
5. Entry tags, properly completed with the exhibitor's name, address, the class number, and the cultivar name (s) must accompany each entry. The TOP AND BOTTOM sections MUST be completed. Each specimen must have its own entry tag except where a collection is shown in one container. In such cases the varieties may be listed on the reverse of the entry tag.
6. All containers are supplied, unless otherwise noted. Use of any transparent material for wedging a specimen in a container is permitted and must be provided by the exhibitor. If wedging material is used, it should not extend above the lip of the container such that it distracts from the exhibit.

7. All entries must have been grown by the exhibitor in his or her private outdoor garden. No more than one person (or couple) may exhibit from the same garden.
8. One bloom per stem hybrid teas, grandifloras, floribundas, miniatures, and minifloras must be exhibited without side buds. Side buds are permitted on all other specimens. Only shrubs, Old Garden Roses, and Species roses may be exhibited stem on stem.
9. Sprays of roses will be exhibited as naturally grown, grooming is allowed consistent with ARS rules.
10. Points toward the ARS Sweepstakes Certificate will be:
(3) Blue Ribbon, (2) Red Ribbon, (1) Yellow Ribbon,
(4) Queen, (3) King, (2) Princess, (1) Prince
11. Only one (1) entry per exhibitor is permitted in Challenge Classes I – XV. In Challenge Class XVI (Judges Class), entries will be limited to four (4) entries per exhibitor per type of rose specified (ie HT, GR, Mini). Multiple entries are permitted in all other classes as long as each entry is a different named variety.
12. All entries become the property of The Pittsburgh Rose Society. No entries may be removed by the exhibitor prior to the close of the show on September 14.
13. Perpetual Trophies will be returned in 2020 to the Trophy Chairman on request. Only members of The Pittsburgh Rose Society are eligible to retain the perpetual trophies. All others will be mailed a certificate.
14. Trophies will be awarded to only Blue-Ribbon winners *except* for the Color Classes in the Royal Court as noted in the Trophy Schedule.

CHALLENGE CLASSES

(Only one entry per exhibitor in Classes I – XV)

Class I – 3 matched **Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora blooms**, different varieties, exhibition stage, separate vases.

Class II – 1 **Hybrid Tea** bloom, 1 **Grandiflora** bloom, & 1 **Floribunda Spray** exhibition stage, separate vases.

Class III – 6 or more **Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora** blooms in 1 vase. Vase supplied by exhibitor.

Class IV – Cycle of Bloom. 1 bud, sepals down, starting to unfurl, 1 exhibition form bloom, and 1 open bloom, stamens showing. All of the same variety, **Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora**, in 1 vase.

Class V – 6 or more **Miniature** blooms, exhibition stage in 1 vase. Vase supplied by the exhibitor.

Class VI – Cycle of Bloom. 1 bud, sepals down, starting to unfurl, 1 exhibition form bloom, and 1 open bloom, stamens showing. All of the same variety, **Miniature or Miniflora**, in 1 vase.

Class VII – 2 **Miniflora** roses; one variety and 4 **Miniatures**; 2 varieties (2 and 2) exhibition stage, separate containers. Entry should be grouped with Minifloras side by side and the 4 miniatures side by side placed in front of the Minifloras.

Class VIII – English Box, **any large rose**, 2 or more varieties, no foliage. English Box provided by exhibitor. Eligible for ARS Best English Box Regular Certificate

Class IX – English Box, **Miniature or Miniflora** roses, 2 or more varieties, no foliage. English Box provided by exhibitor.

Class X – Rose in a Bowl, **any large rose**, exhibition STAGE, no foliage. Bowl supplied by rose society. Eligible for ARS Best Rose Bowl, Large Bloom Certificate

Class XI – Rose in a Bowl, any **Miniature rose**, exhibition STAGE, no foliage. Bowl supplied by rose society. Eligible for ARS Best Rose Bowl, Miniature Bloom Certificate

Class XII – Rose in a Bowl, any **Miniflora rose**, exhibition STAGE, no foliage. Bowl supplied by rose society. Eligible for ARS Miniflora Rose Bowl Certificate.

Class XIII – Rose in a Frame, **any large rose**, exhibition STAGE, no foliage. Frame supplied by rose society.

Class XIV – Rose in a Frame, **Miniature or Miniflora** rose, exhibition STAGE, no foliage. Frame supplied by rose society.

Class XV – Artist Palette, 6 **Miniature or Miniflora** roses, each a different variety, exhibition STAGE, no foliage. Palette supplied by exhibitor.

Class XVI – Judges Class – Open only to judges that are judging this show. Entries limited to four each of the categories listed below. Best in class eligible for ARS Best Judge's Entry Certificate.

- A. **HT or GR** – 1 Exhibition Bloom
- B. **Miniature or Miniflora** – 1 Exhibition Bloom

HORTICULTURE CLASSES

All roses in these classes will be entered and judged alphabetically. Subclasses will be established for each variety from A to Z.

Class 1 **Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora**, one exhibition FORM bloom, no side buds
Entries to be placed alphabetically within color groups. (The **Hybrid Tea** Court, Queen, King, Princess, and Prince will be selected from the blue-ribbon winners in this class)

- A. White
- B. Yellow, Yellow Blend
- C. Orange, Orange Blend, Orange Red, & Orange Pink
- D. Pink, Pink Blend
- E. Red, Red Blend
- F. Mauve, Mauve Blend, & Russet
- G. Apricot, Apricot Blend

- Class 2 **Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora**, one spray, two or more exhibition blooms per stem, Side buds permitted. Eligible for *ARS Best Spray Certificate*
- Class 3 **Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora**, three specimen blooms, exhibition stage, same variety, one vase supplied by the Rose Society.
- Class 4 **Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora**, three specimen blooms, exhibition stage, three different varieties, one color, one vase supplied by the Rose Society.
- Class 5 **Open Bloom, Hybrid Tea**, stamens showing. Eligible for *ARS Best Hybrid Tea Open Bloom Certificate*.
- Class 6 **Floribunda Spray**, two or more blooms per stem. Eligible for *ARS Best Floribunda Spray Certificate*
- Class 7 **Floribunda, one bloom per stem**. Eligible for *ARS Best Floribunda One- Bloom Certificate*.
- Class 8 **Modern Shrub**. Varieties listed as Shrubs (S). One bloom or spray. In this group, stem-on-stem is permitted. (The **Modern Shrub Court**, Queen, King, Princess, and Prince will be selected from the blue-ribbon winners in this class)
- Class 9 **Classic Shrub**. One bloom or spray. Varieties listed as Hybrid Musk, Hybrid Rugosa, Hybrid Moyesii, or Kordesii are eligible for this class. Roses listed as shrubs (S) are not eligible in this class. In this group, stem-on-stem is permitted. Species rugosas must be entered in the Old Garden Rose class. Eligible for *ARS Best Classic Shrub Certificate*.
- Class 10 **Old Garden Rose**. One bloom or spray. Any rose listed as a Species or Old Garden Rose in the ARS listing. The date of introduction **MUST** be listed on the entry tag. In this group, stem-on-stem is permitted. Eligible for *ARS Certificate*.
- Class 11 **Polyantha Spray**. Two or more blooms per stem. Side buds permitted. Eligible for *ARS Best Polyantha Spray Certificate*
- Class 12 **Large Climbers**. One bloom or spray. Varieties must be listed as Large Flowered Climber (LCL), Hybrid Wichurana (HWich), or Hybrid Gigantea (HG). Climbing Hybrid Teas and Climbing Sports must be exhibited in their regular classes and NOT in this class. Eligible for *ARS Best Climber Certificate*.
- Class 13 **One Miniature Bloom**. (The **Miniature Court**, Queen, King, Princess, and Prince will be selected from the blue-ribbon winners in this class). Miniatures classified as “singles” are not eligible in this class. One bloom per stem, exhibition stage, no sidebuds.

- Class 14 **One Miniflora Bloom.** (The **Miniflora Court**, Queen, King, Princess, and Prince will be selected from the blue-ribbon winners in this class). Minifloras classified as “singles” are not eligible in this class. One bloom per stem, exhibition stage, no sidebuds.
- Class 15 **Miniature or Miniflora Single Bloom** (4-8 petals). Eligible for *ARS Certificate*.
- Class 16 **Miniature Open Bloom.** More than $\frac{3}{4}$ open and stamens must show. Miniatures classified as “singles” are not eligible in this class. Eligible for *ARS Miniature Open Bloom Certificate*.
- Class 17 **Miniflora Open Bloom.** More than $\frac{3}{4}$ open and stamens must show. Minifloras classified as “singles” are not eligible in this class. Eligible for *ARS Miniflora Open Bloom Certificate*.
- Class 18 **Miniature Spray.** Two or more blooms per stem. Side buds permitted. Eligible for *ARS Miniature Spray Certificate*.
- Class 19 **Miniflora Spray.** Two or more blooms per stem. Side buds permitted. Eligible for *ARS Miniflora Spray Certificate*.
- Class 20 **Fragrance Class.** Any variety of rose judged for fragrance but consideration will be given to form. Eligible for *ARS Best Fragrance Certificate*.
- Class 21 **Novice.** Limited to individuals who have never won a blue-ribbon at an ARS rose show. Individuals limited to no more than 3 entries in each of the sub sections listed below. Best in Class will be eligible for ARS Best Novice Certificate.
- A. **Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora.** One exhibition bloom. Blue ribbon winner is eligible for court.
- B. **Hybrid Tea or Grandiflora Open Bloom.** One specimen more than $\frac{3}{4}$ open with stamens showing.
- C. **Modern Shrub.** Varieties listed as Shrubs (S). One bloom or spray. In this group, stem-on-stem is permitted. Blue-ribbon winner is eligible for shrub court.
- D. **Miniature or Miniflora rose,** one exhibition bloom. Blue-ribbon winners are eligible for Miniature or Miniflora court.
