We also had three quality mini arrangements and a table of Bidwell student entries.

Art & Bonnie Bishop's Spellbound was the Queen. **Louise Estes** was the King grown by Larry Grundler. **Moonstone** was Princess, **Veteran's Honor** took Prince—both from Larry Grundler's garden.

In the miniatures, Larry Grundler's Joy captured the Queen. Bill Dorn's Bee's Knees was the King. Ann Kubik's Kristin got the Princess trophy. **Rainbow's End** was chosen as the Prince and was entered by Ann Kubik.

In the Challenge Classes, Challenge Class I (3 matched HT/GR, different varieties), was won by Larry Grundler with **Louise Estes, Marilyn Monroes, and Gemini**. Challenge Class II (1 HT bloom, 1GR bloom, 1 FL bloom) had no winner. Challenge Class III (6 or more HT/GR in 1 vase) was won by Larry Grundler with assorted unnamed varieties. Larry Grundler also won Challenge Class IV (1 bud, 1 exhibition stage, 1 open bloom) with **Veteran's Honor**. Challenge Class V (6 or more specimen blooms). Challenge Class VI (3 minis, 1 variety 3 stages) was won by **Baby Boomer** grown by Ann Kubik. Challenge Class VII and Challenge Class VIII (English Box) had no entries. Ann Kubik won Challenge Class IX (Mini English Box) with 6 lovely **Party Girl** blooms. Larry Grundler's **Dublin** was the Best Floater (Challenge Class X) and Judy Gery's **Roby Ruby** won the best Mini Floater (Challenge Class XI). Larry Grundler had the best Rose in a Frame (Challenge Class XII) with **Cary Grant**. Ann Kubik won best mini Rose in a Frame (Challenge Class XIII) with **Edisto**. There was no winner for the Artist's Palette (Challenge Class XIV). There were no entries in the Judges' classes.

The arrangements voted on by the public awarded the favorite small arrangement to Ann Kubik. The large arrangement class had no entries. From the Bidwell arrangements, the favorite award went to Nicole Henderson.

Larry Grundler won the **large sweepstakes** and Ann Kubik won the **mini sweepstakes**.
