In the Challenge Classes, there was no winner for Challenge Class I (3 matched HT/GR, different varieties), Challenge Class II (1 HT bloom, 1 GR bloom, 1 FL bloom) was won by Richard Anthony & Kristine Vance with their entry of **Ebb Tide, Marilyn Monroe and Honey Dijon**. Challenge Class III (6 or more HT/GR in 1 vase) had no winner. The Challenge Class IV trophy (1 bud, 1 exhibition stage, 1 open bloom) was won by Richard Anthony & Kristine Vance with their entry of **Moonstone**. Betty Monyok won the trophy for Challenge Class V (6 or more specimen blooms) with her entry of **Raspberry Punch**, and her entry of **Hilde** won the trophy for Challenge Class VI (3 minis, 1 variety 3 stages). Challenge Class VII (2 Mini-Floras and 4 Minis) was won by John Consigliero with his entry of **Regina Lee, Miss Flippins & X-Rated**. Richard Anthony & Kristine Vance's entry of **Gemini** was good enough to win Challenge Class VIII (English Box). The Best Mini English Box, (Challenge Class XI) was won by Betty Monyok with a box of **Odessa**. **Artic Circle** entered by Richard Anthony & Kristine Vance was the Best Floater (Challenge Class X), and their **First Choice** won the best Mini Floater

(Challenge Class XI). Russell Brown had the best Rose in a Frame (Challenge Class XII) with *Touch of Class*, and Richard Anthony & Kristine Vance won best mini Rose in a Frame (Challenge Class XIII) with *Bee's Knees*. Betty Monyok entered the best Artist's Palette (Challenge Class XIV). In the Judges classes, Peter & Susan Schneider had the best HT/GR and also the best Mini/Mini Flora. The arrangements voted on by the public awarded a blue ribbon to Betty Monyok for the large arrangement, and to Dorothy Zenkevich for the small arrangement. Dick Oberlander won the large sweepstakes and Richard Anthony & Kristine Vance won the mini sweepstakes.
